

Volkswagen Transporter

The Transporter is part of TBC's new Volkswagen T6 Range. The range was developed to meet the need for larger, more flexible vehicles.



The Transporter can be configured for rear or side entrance, for drive from wheelchair or upfront passenger purposes (with flattened floor) as well as internal transfer - and is tested for wheelchairs up to 200kg. They also feature inboard or under floor lift options.

VW Crafter **Liberation VC680** Wheelchair **Accessible Motor** Home

This is the first time a VW Crafter has been adapted for use by disabled people looking for the classic campervan experience. The surprise is that the interior feels nothing less than spacious due to the van's long wheelbase, with cleverly designed partitions that screen off the wetroom from the living area. The design also achieves ease of movement for a wheelchair user. A tracking hoist runs the length of the interior and can be used to help people to bathe in the

van's wetroom or to get in and out of bed. (There are also wheelchair tie downs.)

The rear layout is based around a lounge area with two sofas and a dining room table. The rear double doors of the VW crafter have large privacy tinted windows and can also be opened up when dining. The table folds down to neatly stow away, after which the sofas convert to a double bed.

The campervan is bright and airy throughout with beautiful upholstery and smart wood finishing providing a touch of class and a great deal of appeal.

The eTrike is an electric assist version of the well-known Mountain Trike. It will appeal to people who find they require a bit of assistance when travelling off road or for others who will use the extra power to tackle even more challenging terrain.

The 250w hub motor powered by a 36v 12Ah Li-ion battery has an excellent

range (dependent on user weight and conditions) and is powerful enough to cope with rough surfaces and hill climbs alike.
